Independent Public School

From 2024, Yangebup Primary School will become an Independent Public School! This is an acknowledgement from the Education Department that we are an effective school that works with community to make positive change. We also have the added bonus of having more flexibility when we choose new staff.

This is a huge milestone for Yangebup Primary!

Open Night

In Week 5, Thursday 9th November, YPS will be hosting our annual Open Night. Classrooms will be open from 4pm until 5.30pm. Following that, we would love families to stay on and enjoy a picnic on the school grounds. There will be some food vans available or you can bring your own picnic. Class Placements for 2024

Staff work very hard in Term 4 to place students in classes for the following year. You can read our Class Placement Policy and our Split Grade Policy on our website www.yangebupps.wa.edu.au. We try to ensure that each class has a range of abilities (split classes included) and that each student has at least one friend. If a student has been in a split class one year, if possible, they are put in a straight class the following year. It is important to understand that split classes are not organised based on ability (we favour independent students for these classes).

If there are any educational or behavioural issues that you think need to be brought to our attention **before** we place students, please let me know by email by **Friday** 10th November. Parents cannot request a particular teacher or not to be in a split class. Please note that I have not finalised allocating teachers to grades as yet.

Students will have the opportunity to meet their new teacher for an hour on the last day of school and class lists will be posted in the library windows the day before. Students cannot be changed once classes are set because there are so many factors that go into the decisions so please do not ask for changes.


