

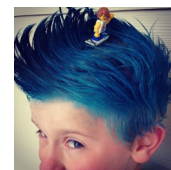
They will also be holding a Crazy Hair Day (**Friday 28th October**).
