Learning Tips for Parents: Maths - Basic Facts


Did you know that not only do students need to learn their times tables, they also need to learn basic addition and subtraction facts?

They should start by learning the facts that add up to 10. That is: 1+9, 2+8, 3+7, 4+6 and 5+5. If you ask what number do I need to add to 8 to get 10, students also begin to see the relationship between addition and subtraction.

Next, they need to know double numbers. That is: 6+6, 7+7 etc.

Once they have these memorised, students can start using these facts to work out others. For example: If I know $6+6 = 12$, then $6+7 =$ one more, which is 13. Also, if I know $7+3 = 10$ then $7+5$ is two more, which is 12.

This is the basis for fast mental calculation and well worth learning!


P&C News
