NAPLAN Year 3 and 5 Individual Reports

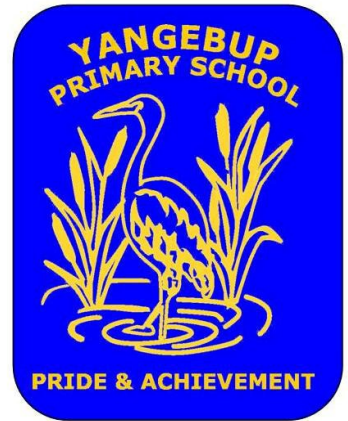

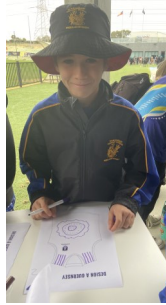
100 DAYS OF SCHOOL

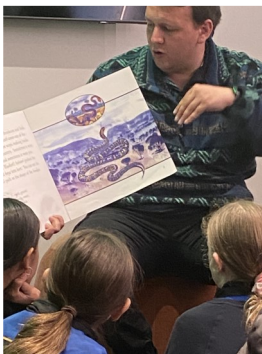
